COMMON REGISTRATION QUESTIONS



- Q. Does the parent/guardian have to register the child?
A. Yes, only the custodial parent(s) or legal guardian(s) are able to register a student.
- Q. Does my child have to attend the registration process?
A. No, your child does not have to be present at registration.
- Q. How old does my child have to be to register for preschool and kindergarten?
A. Your child must be four by October 1, 2012, to register for preschool. Your child must be five by October 1, 2012, to register for kindergarten.
- Q. Does my child need to be tested for preschool and/or kindergarten?
A. No, there is no testing involved.
- Q. Is preschool a full day program?
A. No, the preschool program has two sessions:
AM Session is from 8:45 AM - 11:15 AM
PM Session is from 12:45 PM- 3:15 PM
Class size is limited and your child may be put on a waiting list for future openings.
- Q. Is kindergarten a full day program?
A. Yes, kindergarten is a full day program. The hours are 8:45 AM - 3:15 PM.
- Q. Does my child need a school physical and updated immunization records in order to register for school?
A. Yes, all new students must have a physical exam by a physician. The medical form will be provided from the school nurse or the registrar and is also available on our website. Your child must have all immunizations up to date before the start of school. If you have any questions you can contact the main office at extension 1010. ***No child will be considered registered until all medical requirements are met.***
- Q. Does Clementon Elementary School offer before and after child care?
A. Yes, we offer a fee based program, Camp Clementon, for our kindergarten students.
